The International Awards (previously known as the Duke of Edinburgh Award) is a self-development programme for 14 to 25 year olds. To gain the award, participants must complete activities in four Sections, namely Service, Adventurous Journey, Practical Skills and Physical Recreation for a specified minimum period of time. Students at the Australian International School Malaysia have won the International Awards under the Gold Category in previous years, which is the highest category.
