## Australian International School Does Malaysia Proud in World Scholar's Cup SEA Regional, Singapore

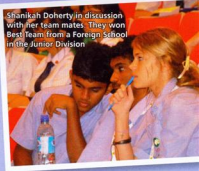
The Australian International School Malaysia (AISM) brought home 19 medals, 3 trophies in the World Scholar's Cup South East Asian Regional recently. The World Scholar's Cup is a global academic competition and team extracurricular activity, with participation in the South-East Asia region of more than 300 students from Indonesia, Malaysia, Vietnam, Singapore, Thailand and the Philippines. It's like the academic Olympics.

This year, the Australian International School Malaysia sent a contingent of 30 students, its biggest ever, to the competition.

The "Scholaroos" (the name adopted by the World Scholar's team)

competed against the best and brightest and won the title of Best Team and Best Student from a Foreign

School in both the Junior & Senior Divisions. The Junior Division's debate team on the other hand, won the overall 4th place in the team debate competition. One of the scholaroos was even selected to the Debate Showcase, an event that featured the best 6 debaters in the competition competing in front of an auditorium audience. The Scholaroos also got individual medals in Debating and Essay Writing.
